



Special Meeting with Work Session

July 25, 2022

Call To Order: The Board met at the Council Chambers of the Village of Richfield. The meeting was called to order at 6:02 pm by Anita Gantner, Board Chair.

Work Session

Strategic Plan progress review and discussion with Stakeholders: Ms. Coffman read the RJRD Mission Statement and emphasized everything we do should relate back to the overall mission. She commented on how the organization is structured – the RJRD Board of Trustees direct the work of the Park Director, and all groups should support that work. Ms. Irland discussed the Trails Team, what has been done to date regarding trails, programming, and community engagement, as well as plans to move forward regarding maps, trails, and programs. Ms. Coffman discussed the need for the park to outline a path forward as well as the need for the Governance Committee to outline a clear hierarchy of roles and responsibilities. Jen Grieser, Cleveland Metroparks Director of Natural Resources, discussed the park's natural resources and the excellent quality of streams and wetlands.

Ms. Coffman reviewed the results of the survey. The park received 481 responses of which 249 were responses from Richfield residents. Ms. Coffman discussed the existing buildings and asked meeting attendees to select their top 5 buildings to save.
