

RESOLUTION NO. 02-2026

Offered by the Richfield Joint Recreation District Board of Trustees

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING BIDS FOR OPTIONS “A” AND “B” OF THE 2026 HERITAGE PRESERVE PAVEMENT REHABILITATION AND AUTHORIZING A CONTRACT THEREFOR WITH CARDINAL ASPHALT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to legal notice therefor, duly published according to law, six (6) sealed bids were received at the office of the Richfield Joint Recreation District (“RJR”), Summit County, Ohio, at the Richfield Heritage Preserve Office, 4374 Broadview Road, Richfield, Ohio 44286 for labor and materials for asphalt pavement rehabilitation at the Richfield Heritage Preserve for 2026 in accordance with specifications prepared by GPD Group (“Engineer”);

WHEREAS, pursuant thereto, the lowest and best bids received for said labor and materials for Options “A” and “B” of the 2026 Heritage Preserve Pavement Rehabilitation (the “Project”), as recommended by the Engineer, are:

Option “A”, BASE BID GENERAL: Cardinal Asphalt in the amount of \$77,665.00; and

Option “B”, BID ALTERNATE (Paving from Lodge to Amity House): Cardinal Asphalt in the amount of \$32,920.00.

WHEREAS, Ohio State Capital Grant 2024-2026 grant cycle funds from State of Ohio Fund 7031 or 7035 shall be utilized for the cost of Option “A.”

NOW, THEREFORE, Be it Resolved by the Trustees of the Richfield Joint Recreation District, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That the bids of Cardinal Asphalt for labor and materials for Options “A” and “B” of the Project, as set forth in the recitals of this Resolution, are accepted by this Board as the lowest and best bids therefor and the Chairperson and Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract with Cardinal Asphalt for Options “A” and “B” of the Project for a total amount not to exceed \$110,585.00.

Section 2. The Chairperson and Treasurer are hereby authorized and directed to take all actions necessary to apply for and receive reimbursement to the RJRD from the State of Ohio for the cost of Option “A”.

Section 3. That all formal actions of this Board concerning this resolution were taken in an open meeting of the Board and all deliberations of this Board and any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with applicable law.

Section 4. That this Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety and welfare and for the further reason that it is necessary to enter into contract as soon as possible to complete the necessary asphalt pavement rehabilitation during the 2026 construction season; wherefore, provided this Resolution receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the Trustees appointed, it shall take effect immediately upon its passage and execution by the Chairperson; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
